**Compost helps prevent pollution** by avoiding the production of methane and leachate formulation in landfills. Compost has the ability to prevent pollutants in stormwater runoff from reaching surface water resources.

2. **Soil Amendment/Fertilizer:** Super Doo® contains the vitamins your plants need to thrive. Loosen soil around annuals/perennials, add 1-2 inches of Super Doo®, and till into the soil with a small spade or with your hands. For best results: after the first rainfall, till the soil again, being sure to mix the Super Doo® into the earth around your plants.
